



NO UNNECESSARY HOMEWORK

But wait, it's all homework, isn't it? Well, not quite; online homeschooling offers children a more personalised and structured approach to their education. This means that parents and children spend far less time doing unnecessary homework, which allows the child more time to explore hobbies and other activities.

It also frees up parents from having to do lengthy evening homework sessions and it means that they can spend more quality time with their children. Online homeschooling programmes encourage children to discover the joy of learning by taking responsibility for their progress and allowing the child to have freedom and flexibility in their learning. There are many benefits to choosing online homeschooling for your child's education.

2

FLEXIBILITY

Parents with children in a traditional school environment often have to cope with busy school schedules, extramurals and other commitments. Children (and parents) can be exhausted by the never-ending 'to-do' lists and daily tasks. With online schooling, parents can decide the length of the lessons and customise their children's schedules to suit their needs (including when to finally go on that holiday). This means less pressure on families to stick to a strict learning calendar.

CambriLearn believes in flexible, self-paced learning. Students can set the tempo of their learning, meaning they can speed up or slow down depending on what they can manage at the time. This is the reason many top child athletes or performers choose homeschooling over a traditional schooling environment. To professionally compete, students need the flexibility to train, travel, and study.

3 LESS SOCIAL ANXIETY

Even though studying in a school develops peer groups and teaches a child to socialise, at the same time, it can give birth to unnecessary negative competition. The race for grades can develop a negative attitude toward learning and the immense pressure to perform can affect students' mental health and social values.

Homeschooling eliminates this kind of intense negative pressure and lets children focus on their subjects rather than their grades. In this way, they can develop an in-depth knowledge of their subjects as well as an appreciation for them. Children who are homeschooled have a much lower chance of being bullied, offered drugs, or exposed to other social pressures, and are therefore much less likely to experience symptoms of depression and anxiety.

4 CONTROL OVER THE MATTER

Homeschooling gives you the freedom and flexibility to teach your child the way you want to teach. There thus remains no scope for dissatisfaction about the way in which your child is being taught by someone else. You can focus on specific methods of teaching or the subjects your child is weak in.

Online homeschooling lessons allow you to pick and choose what you wish to teach your child, thereby incorporating them into a larger teaching scheme. You can also fix the duration of their study to give core attention to areas in which they

are weak. In short, the lessons you provide your child are tailor-made according to your vision and your knowledge of their personality.

5 SAFE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

Parents who are in any doubt about the safety of their children in schools could consider the alternative option of homeschooling. Students generally feel safe and comfortable in their homes with online homeschooling lessons. It keeps them away from issues like bullying and negative company which may adversely affect or influence them. Even though these issues do not occur in every school, online homeschooling still remains a better option for parents who worry about the safety of their children.

6 SOLUTIONS FOR CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

The ability to focus and to sit quietly at a desk is often associated with a student's level of academic success, and for students with ADD and ADHD, this is near impossible. For many students listening to directions, retaining information and completing assignments are daunting tasks.

The advantage of online classes is that they are designed for students who need more flexibility and offer a more personalised approach to their learning preferences. Another great benefit of online homeschooling is that it offers the chance for students with social anxiety the opportunity to interact with their teachers in an online environment. This can increase their confidence to talk

about their areas of doubt and thus gain a better understanding of the subject being studied.

7 PARENT-CHILD BONDING

In online homeschooling, parents will spend more time helping their children with the online tutoring they receive, and this creates personal bonds that are positively nurtured through education. Education that fosters a personal touch and an emotional bond is the most humane and creates well-rounded individuals. It saves students from becoming too mechanical and competition-oriented, unlike those who are put under immense pressure to perform and who thus detach themselves from everything around them in order to secure “first in class”.

8 LESS PRESSURE ON PARENTS

It may sound somewhat surprising, but homeschooling can actually lessen some of the pressure on parents. On the one hand, it is true that homeschooling requires a parent to be at home with the child and focus on their education, which can be quite time-consuming.

On the other hand, it lessens the unnecessary pressure put on parents to assist with deadline-driven projects, tests, homework, assignments, and compulsory extra-mural activities. Daily homework submissions and weekly project deadlines invariably create pressure

on parents who need to help their children with this work under time constraints. In the case of homeschooling, you can assist your children in creative project work at your own convenience and make the learning process creative and fun, instead of pressurised. Working parents also have the convenience of opting for tutor assistance which further reduces the pressure on them.

9 HYBRID LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

It has become increasingly popular for parents to use local tutors to support their child’s online learning. Enrolling your child with a tutor will give them the benefits of the classroom environment while still offering the benefits of one-on-one teacher interaction and smaller classes. Tutors help students learn at their comfort level as well as give them the chance to interact with other children of all ages.

10 BETTER SOCIAL SKILLS

A common deterrent for parents considering homeschooling is the misconception that homeschoolers don’t develop their social skills. This is far from the truth, and it has been shown that larger classes and peer pressure can do more social harm than good. Children who are homeschooled tend to have more time and energy to participate in sporting and social activities with other kids across different age groups. They will have many opportunities to make friends when they do their violin, gymnastics and golf lessons, for example.

11 PREPARES A CHILD FOR UNIVERSITY

Homeschooled students have a head start on building critical career skills, such as time management, self-motivation, and self-discipline. Online homeschooling programmes encourage children to discover the joy of learning and take responsibility for their progress. By allowing a child to have this freedom in their learning, they tend to adjust better to a university environment.

12 NURTURE A CHILD'S UNIQUE TALENTS

Traditional schools tend to make students only focus on their studies and academic ranking. This subdues the talents a child may have within them and there may be no opportunity for that talent to be discovered or developed. Homeschooling gives students and parents the opportunity to focus on the inherent talents of the child and nurture them as well. For instance, a child who is musically oriented can be given music classes through online homeschooling alongside their academic lessons, and at an hour convenient to them. This will widen the child's education and make it a more progressive experience.

13 SAVES TIME

Homeschooling is a noticeably more efficient way of schooling. There is far less time wasted on mundane routines, like assemblies and drive time etc. This means that you can better invest that time in actual learning and teaching for your child, where they can be helped by pre-planned, self-guided lessons that allow them to learn independently. In the long run, your daily routine can be far better optimised with this kind of learning.

Learning to Read and Write

An emphasis on listening, speaking and reading forms the basis of our Learning to Read and Write course. Students beginning their reading and writing journey will also learn to blend sounds, decode unfamiliar words by breaking them down into sounds, and read a simple story.

Entry Requirements: Familiarity with the letters of the alphabet.

Primary Stages 1-6

CambriLearn's Primary Stages offer English, Mathematics, Science, and Social and Emotional Learning courses.

Each course has a structured lesson plan that has been created by professionally trained and qualified teachers. Students will have access to live online lessons, and a recorded lesson library, to which they can refer if they are experiencing any difficulties with a specific topic.

The student's progress is tracked on CambriLearn's Student Tracker. Students will also complete assignments and mock exams, which are marked by their teachers. The marked assessments and mock exams will have individualised feedback to help the student improve.

Entry Requirements for Grade 1: Students must know how to read, thereafter progression to the next grade will be based on completion of the previous grade (or an equivalent). E.g. A student must complete Grade 1 in order to progress to Grade 2.

Foundation I and II

CambriLearn's Foundation I and II curriculum include two levels which are aligned with the International British Lower Secondary curriculum.

The Foundation I and Foundation II courses are designed to prepare for the next phase of the student's education; International GCSE (or IGCSE). CambriLearn's courses are aligned with the core subjects of English, Mathematics, and Science.

Language options: Our subject-expert teachers have created age-appropriate courses for Afrikaans, French, and Spanish to prepare students for second languages at higher levels. At this level, students have the option of a unique CambriLearn EMS (Economic and Management Science) course which introduces the International GCSE commerce subjects.

Entry Requirements: Primary Stage 6 or an equivalent.



International GCSE

CambriLearn's International GCSE curriculum builds on the foundation of the Lower Secondary levels. The International GCSE Exam is written at an independent Cambridge exam centre, and is a globally recognised exam.

CambriLearn offers courses for English First and First Additional Language, Accounting, Afrikaans, Biology, Business Studies, Chemistry, Economics, French, History, Core Mathematics, Mathematics, Physics, Geography, and Information and Communication Technology.

Entry Requirements: Foundation II or an equivalent

AS and A Levels

The International British Curriculum's A Level is a two-year course that ends with an internationally recognised examination usually written at age 18. These two years are split between two levels at CambriLearn: the first year is covered in the AS Level courses and the second year is covered in the A Level courses. This enables students to choose to write only the AS Level examinations or to proceed to the full A Level course over two years.

A British Advanced curriculum is typically for learners aged 16 to 19 years who need advanced study to prepare for university and higher education.

Entry Requirements: Students must have done CambriLearn's International GCSE or an equivalent.



INTRODUCING PEARSON EDEXCEL

For those students who are interested in studying the sciences but do not have access to a Cambridge-approved exam centre that caters to the physical practical exam requirements, we offer Pearson Edexcel.



Printed vs. digital textbooks


Firstly, you should decide whether you would prefer printed or electronic textbooks. 




Step 3: Contact a reliable bookseller, sharing the list of needed textbooks along with ISBN numbers and your address. Make your payment and ask for an estimated delivery date for better planning.

Step 4: Be patient as you wait. International curriculum textbooks, often from Europe, may have delivery delays due to factors like sea freight and unexpected events. CambridgeLearn has partnered with Eduwiz to provide textbooks at affordable prices. Online purchases are dispatched daily. Selection can be made from both New copies or Used copies.




